



2020-2021 FELLOWSHIPS / ARTIST RESIDENCY “AFRICA MULTIPLE”

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

To apply for a fellowship, please use the online application form available at:

In addition to the general information about your academic profile you are asked to provide the following items:

- a cover letter explaining your motivation to apply for an Academy fellowship and indicating the envisaged time period of the same (max. 3,500 characters, roughly equivalent to 500-600 words);
- your CV (to be uploaded as one pdf file);
- an outline (max. 13,000 characters, roughly equivalent to 2,000-2,200 words) of the art project you are proposing to realize as a Fellow. You may add up to 10 photos and sketches;
- a brief statement (max. 3,500 characters, roughly equivalent to 500-600 words) sketching the intended contribution to the Cluster’s agenda;
- a brief statement explaining how any or all the following aspects of diversity will be interrogated in your project: gender and sexuality; class and socioeconomic positionalities; religious and racial politics; disability politics; intersectional readings of power relations; historicisation of colonial influences on African (continental and diasporic) artistic practices and productions (max. 3,500 characters, roughly equivalent to 500-600 words);
- your complete list of publications, if applicable (to be uploaded as one pdf file);
- the names of the Bayreuth-based scholar(s) with whom collaborations are intended. These can be colleagues in the Iwalewahaus, and / or other Cluster members. You may also name existing formats (like the African Film Festival, the Swahili Colloquium or the BIGSAS Literature Festival) you would like to join;
- names and contact details of two referees.

Please note that you have to complete and submit the application form in its entirety; the system does not allow you to save your data and return to the form later. **We therefore recommend that you prepare all required items before starting to fill the form.**

Closing date is June 30, 2020, 23:59 CEST. Applicants will be informed of the selection decision no earlier than the beginning of August 2020.
